Draw a diagram to show how you did your test.	Make a healthy meal for Mr Greedy. What can he eat lots of without getting sick? Take a photo of your meal.	Design and make Mr Tickle a really effective tickle stick. What materials work best? How can you test to see?	Write your own new Mr Man or Little Miss story.
Think of some regular exercise that you really like and see if you can make yourself stronger, like Mr Strong. How can you test this?	Little Miss Late is never on time but can you be? Learn to tell the time better. Do you know all the numbers on the clock? Can you find half past? How about quarter to and quarter past? You could draw and label a clock face with everything you know.	Mr Happy likes making other people happy. Can you think of things to do to help other people and make them happy? Visit grandma and make her a present? Breakfast in bed for mum? What can you do? Take a photo of what you do.	Make a 3D model of one of the Mr Men or Little Miss characters.	Read as many of the Mr Men / Little Miss stories as you can.
Have a really good tidy up like Little Miss Tidy. It could be in the garden or in the house, or just a messy cupboard. Sort it out!	Little Miss Greedy loves eating. Learn to use the scales and a measuring jug in your kitchen and then make her something yummy. Reception learn the words heavier and lighter and find heavy and light things for Miss Greedy to eat.	Little Miss Chatterbox loves chatting to people. Talk to someone older than you and find out what it was like at school when they were little. Draw a picture or write some notes.	Design and make a house the right size for Mr Small. He's about 5cm tall. Use a ruler and make things the right size.	Did you know Little Miss Somersault has been written in French? Learn some action words in French for her. Google translate might be helpful.
Mr Muddle can't find his way about. Can you make a map of your garden or park that would help him?	Mr Forgetful can't remember anything but can you? Learn a new times table. (We start with 2x,10x,5x,3x...) or reception children learn to write some really big numbers.	Find out what an adjective is and then make up characters to suit all the people you know using adjectives - Mr Friendly, Miss Jolly, Mr Healthy etc. Write a list.	Little Miss Inventor can invent just about anything. Make a gadget for doing a job and bring it in to show us.	Re-write a Mr Men story with yourself in it. Reception children can draw and label a Mr Men picture.
