# Eastcombe Explorers

## Music - Glockenspiel

Children will learn about the language of music through playing the glockenspiel.

## PE

PE sessions will be at the village hall. These lessons will develop skills: throwing, catching, jumping, flexibility, control and balance.

## Computing

Children will work with sound digitally and use the 'Audacity' program to produce a podcast.



## Geography - Eastcombe Explorers

Children will learn about key aspects of geography by focusing on the local area. This will include learning about the physical features and human features within Eastcombe. Children will use fieldwork to explore the area, before presenting findings using sketch maps and graphs.

Children will also learn about the land use within Eastcombe, including: the different types of settlement and local economic activity.



## RE - Islam

Children will learn about the religion of Islam, focusing on Muslim beliefs about God and the ways in which they worship.

## RHE - Wellbeing

Children will learn about ways to manage and improve mental wellbeing. They will also spend time learning about economic wellbeing.

## Design & Technology

Children will design digital wearable technology and develop a program and housing for a Micro:bit.

## English

Children will complete non-chronological report writing about our local area (linked to our geography focus). Children will also complete a story writing unit of work, based on *a story from another culture*.

## Science - Sound

Children will learn about how sounds are made, associating some of them with something vibrating. They will recognise that vibrations from sounds travel through a medium to the ear. Children will work scientifically to make earmuffs made from different materials to investigate which provides the best insulation against sound. Children will learn about patterns between the pitch of a sound and features of the object that produced it. They will also find patterns between the volume of a sound and the strength of the vibrations that produced it. Working scientifically, they will make and play their own instruments using what they learn about pitch and volume.

## French - Days and months

Children will learn names of days and months, whilst also recapping basic greetings and ways to talk about ourselves.

## Maths

Children will finish learning about subtraction. Following this, they will complete a multiplication and division unit of work, before learning about area.
