

Geography

'Where does our energy come from?'

During this unit the children will find out about renewable and non-renewable energy sources. We will explore the benefits and drawbacks of the different energy sources. They will learn about the importance of trading and discover some of the important trading routes and how these have changed over time.

Science

In science we are finding out about properties and changes in materials. We will learn that some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution, and describe how to recover a substance from a solution. The children will use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through sieving, filtering and evaporating.

PE

On Mondays and Thursdays, we will be playing football outdoors or dodgeball in the Village hall, depending on the weather.

RHE

This term we will learn some basic first aid. We will also learn about being safe and keeping safe at home and when we are out and about. Some of the children will be completing bikeability to learn how to stay safe whilst cycling on the road.

Art

Mixed media land and cityscapes. We will explore how artists use a variety of media to capture the spirit of a place. Then focus upon exploratory work to discover mixed media combinations.

English

We will begin the term by writing our own cinquains, tankas and haikus (Japanese poetry with a formal structure). We are looking forward to celebrating World Book Day this term and have lots of book related activities planned. We will go on to writing explanation texts about our geography topic.

Maths

In our maths lessons, we begin the term by learning about perimeter, area and volume of shapes. We then continue our learning about decimals by learning how to add, subtract, multiply and divide them. Our final unit this term focuses on fractions, decimals and percentages as we learn to find equivalence and percentages of amounts.

Computing - databases

This unit looks at how a flat-file database can be used to organise data in records. Pupils use tools within a database to order and answer questions about data. They create graphs and charts from their data to help solve problems.

DT - Making a pop-up book

We will create a four-page pop-up story book design, incorporating a range of functional mechanisms that use levers, sliders, layers and spacers to give the illusion of movement through interaction.
