

Geography

This term our topic work has a geography focus as we learn about rivers. We will start with understanding the water cycle. We will be using different maps to locate a range of rivers from the World's largest to our own local river. We will gain an understanding of how they behave and the landforms they create. Our focus will then turn to mountains, we will locate the World's major mountains and understand how they are formed.

PSHE

This term our focus is about mental health. We will look at strategies and behaviours to support our mental health and look after ourselves. We will then shift focus and learn about money; spending and saving and how to make spending decisions.

Science

This term we will learn about the human body. We will describe the changes that happen to our bodies as we grow older and learn the major parts of the human circulatory system and describe the functions of the heart, blood vessels and blood.

ICT

This term, the children will identify what makes a good web page and use this information to design and evaluate their own website using sway.
