Squirrel Class

English

During English, we will focus on traditional tales in our topic 'Once Upon a Time'. We'll delve into the stories through creating our own versions and writing letters in character.

Music

We will look at musical styles including Bossa Nova, Latin and Big Band. We'll also be practicing playing instruments.

Maths

EYFS- we will delve deeply into numbers up to 10. We will also explore length and height and as well as starting work on 3D shapes.

Year 1- we will continue exploring place value to 50 before looking at length, height, mass and volume.

Year 2 - we will continue our work on multiplication and division before exploring length, height, mass, capacity and temperature.

Computing

This term we will be learning about grouping and labelling objects, in preparation for future work on spreadsheets and databases.

Science

In Science we will continue our focus on plants, exploring what plants need to grow and observing plants growing from seeds and bulbs.

Art

We will be learning about the special characteristics of watercolour paints and creating our own works.

RHE

Our focus is keeping safe, including basic first aid and staying safe at home and out and about.

PE

On Mondays we will be learning gymnastics at Thomas Keble School.

On Thursdays we will continue developing our balance and agility through a range of games and activities.

Geography

This term we are focusing on our fieldwork skills. We'll be linking to our topic of traditional tales to explore compass skills, maps and directional language.

Design & Technology

In DT this term we will be learning about mechanisms. We will look at side-to-side and up-and-down sliders, so we can make our own moving story book!
