Maths

EYFS- we will be exploring sharing and grouping as well as looking at patterns, positional language and mapping.

Year 1- we will be learning to recognise coins and notes before exploring time and beginning to learn to tell the time.

Year 2 – we will continue our statistics work exploring tally charts, tables and pictograms before exploring positional language and describing positions and turns.

Geography

We will be further developing our fieldwork skills to answer the question:

Are there enough plants to encourage wildlife at our school?

English

We will be writing informational fact files about bees. We will learn how to use dictionaries to find rich and purposeful language to support our writing.

Computing

This term we will be learning about algorithms and coding and creating our own animations!

PE

On Mondays we will continue to develop our basic skills running, jumping, throwing and catching.

On Thursdays we will participate in team games and learn simple tactics for attacking and defending.

RE

This term we will consider how we should care for the world and others and why it matters.

Music

Science

Art
