In the next few weeks we will let you know when you can collect your Gnome to include in the display, we will ask Mrs Jones to post on DOJO when you'll be able to collect these from the playground. We are asking this year for the displays to be handed in before May half term please, this is to ensure we have plenty of time to check we have all 33 displays but we also need time to match them to their allocated sponsor.
