What is Sport Funding?

The Government provides additional funding for physical education (PE) and sport in schools. This funding is to be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision resulting in increased numbers of pupils developing healthy life styles, raising their performance levels and engaging in PE and sport.

Plans for Sport Funding

For the 2017-18 academic year, Eastcombe Primary School has received £16,000 + £10 per pupil of government funding for PE and school sport with the aim of: improving the provision for PE and sport; raising the standards in teaching and learning and developing the physical fitness and well-being of pupils.

£500	Team kit for sporting fixtures.	<p>Purpose: To ensure children are wearing a team kit that represents Eastcombe Primary School.</p> <p>Outcome: To instil team spirit, pride and sportsmanship in our pupils.</p>
£4780	Mini Marines sessions for Class 2 & 3.	<p>Purpose: To increase the children's fitness levels. To work on sportsmanship, resilience, goal setting, respect, first aid and healthy living.</p> <p>Outcome: Children will have a greater understanding of the importance of fitness and team spirit. The children will have a greater awareness of respect and resilience. The children will also gain basic first aid skills and an understanding of a healthy lifestyle.</p>
£3585	Fund TA's to attend PE lessons.	<p>Purpose: To fund staff to enable our pupils to access the PE curriculum. Due all of our PE facilities being off site we need to employ TA's to be with the teaching staff to ensure safety and ratios.</p> <p>Outcome: Children will be able to access PE lessons at the Village Hall, Scout Hut and Sports Field. Without additional TA support PE lessons could not take place.</p>
£1500	Sports Equipment	<p>Purpose: To develop our range of PE equipment and supplement what we already have. To introduce new sports to our children.</p> <p>Outcome: Children will be able to use resources effectively and staff will be able to deliver PE sessions with the correct equipment. This equipment will last and benefit the school for</p>

		years to come. A range of smaller equipment can also be used to supplement playtimes, further encouraging sports and physical activities.
£400	Cost of hiring the Village Hall and Scout Hut.	<p>Purpose: To ensure children can access the full curriculum and take PE lessons.</p> <p>Outcome: Children will access the full curriculum and take PE lessons indoors. Children will be given the opportunity to improve their skills.</p>
£550	Subsidising cost of residential school trip.	<p>Purpose: To enable children to take part in adventure sports. To increase the range of sports children are exposed to.</p> <p>Outcome: The residential trip is more affordable for all pupils and children are more likely to take part in adventurous sports after the experience.</p>
£60	Annual subscription to SDPSSA	<p>Purpose: To enable our pupils to take part in District Sports events and matches. To enable our staff to attend PE CDP.</p> <p>Outcome: Children will participate in team and individual events at a district level. Staff will develop their knowledge of teaching different sports.</p>
£150	Entry costs to sporting events/match fixtures.	<p>Purpose: To enable our pupils to take part in District Sports events and matches.</p> <p>Outcome: Children will participate in team and individual events at a district level.</p>
£1600	Cricket Lessons & staff CPD. Football coaching & staff CPD	<p>Purpose: To increase the range of sports children are exposed to. For children to develop skills, co-ordination, balance, and stamina. Staff CPD.</p> <p>Outcome: Children will develop their cricket and football skills and staff will receive CPD to teach these sports more effectively in the future.</p>
£500	Staff CPD with REAL PE.	<p>Purpose: To enable new staff members to access the REAL PE scheme we use as a school. Re-training is required. TA's will also join the training to spread the REAL PE experience and knowledge.</p> <p>Outcome: All current staff, including TA's will have REAL PE training thus enabling the scheme to be used effectively. Children will be taught a range of skills more effectively.</p>
