Electricity

Children will identify common appliances that run on electricity and construct simple electrical circuits. This will include identifying and naming basic parts, such as cells, wires, bulbs, switches and buzzers. We will learn to recognise common electrical conductors and insulators. Lastly, children will design and make a small model which uses an electric circuit within it.
